What's the difference between being a chapter member and a CCGHR SYP member?

CHAPTER MEMBERS:

Chapter members are part of the CCGHR through their university. Student chapter members may be connected to the CCGHR if the chapter is supported by an University Advisory Council Liaison, but this is not always the case. As a member of a student chapter, you receive some networking and capacity building opportunities from the SYPN, but do not have access to the full suite of benefits that come from being a part of the CCGHR community.

CCGHR SYP MEMBERS:

CCGHR SYP members pay a \$35/year membership fee to the CCGHR. With this membership fee SYP members receive a number of benefits that are offered to all CCGHR members (a quarterly newsletter, funding resources, access to working groups). SYP members also receive a variety of benefits that were specifically designed with the unique needs and interests of SYPs in mind. These are: bursary opportunities for global health events and conferences, a closed Facebook group for networking and opportunities, a professional application review service, Q&A support, mentoring and professional development support, and much more!

To receive your seed money, you must provide proof of membership to the CCGHR before October 31, 2019. To do this, student chapter presidents should send a list of the members of their chapter who have become CCGHR members to sypn@ccghr.ca
